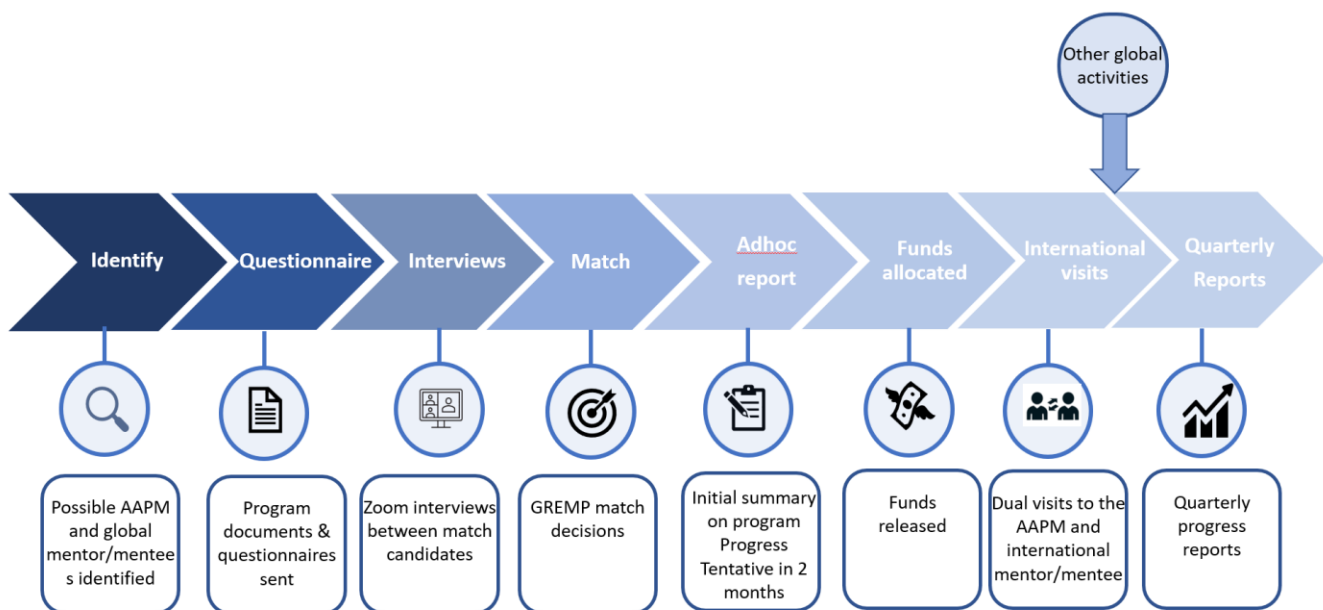


Dear potential Global Research Mentorship Program (GREMP) participants!

We are excited to share with you that the Global Research and Scientific Innovation Committee (GRSIC) of the American Association of Physics in Medicine (AAPM) is launching a **Global Research Mentorship Program (GREMP)**. The GREMP program is aimed at international medical physics mentors and their mentees to enhance and support their mentoring experience through international collaborations. The GREMP will help facilitate collaborations between co-called *mentoring quads*, i.e., *an international mentor and mentee (international Ph.D. advisor and Ph.D. student) and an AAPM mentor and their mentee (AAPM Ph.D. advisor and Ph.D. student)*. We are excited to share that we are offering \$10,000 to support global mentorship activities for each of the two selected mentoring quads this year. The workflow of the GREMP program with an approximate timeline for 2023 is shown here:
